We are very happy to be able to offer our own GLWI Financial Assistance Fund again this spring. While the fund is relatively small, we are eager to grow it over time through our annual appeal and other fundraising events and opportunities.

We have established this fund for several reasons:

- We know that those of you receiving financial aid as Master's Degree students are not able to include the cost of the GLWI Foundations or GLWI Independent Study Fieldwork and Practicum courses in the financial aid determination.
- The value of both of these types of courses to your development as a teacher is high. These are essential courses, and we seek to support your enrollment.
- In the spirit of keeping money moving so that it can truly support everyone's highest intentions, GLWI is reinvesting money we're receiving via tuition in the people who are paying that tuition.

Application criteria:

- Students must be on track for completion, having completed all coursework so far in the cycle since they began the program.
- Students need to be in good academic standing with a B average or above.
- Any incomplete coursework must be completed by November 15, 2018.
- Students may not have any outstanding balances due with GLWI, unless they are clearly on a payment plan.

The application form is included. It is due on the 31st of December 31st. Any applications received after that date will not be considered. Awards will be granted by February 1st.
